

Paul Harris Info on Rotary.org

Wondering when you last donated to The Rotary Foundation, TRF, or how close you are to a Paul Harris Fellowship award? This information is just a few clicks away

- go to www.rotary.org
- click on "sign in/register" and enter your user name and password. **If you have never logged in before, you will be prompted to create an account** by entering your e-mail address and entering a password. Please allow 24 hours for this new account to be activated. If your email is not on file with rotary.org, please contact your Club Secretary.
- in the upper middle line of the screen click on "My Rotary"
- in that screen you will see your name in the upper left hand corner
- place the cursor on your name and a drop down menu will appear
- click on "Profile"
- at the "Profile" page look in the middle of the screen and locate "Donor History Report"
- click on "Donor History Report"
- a screen titled "Individual Reports" should appear
- locate "DonorHistoryReport" and click on it

You will now see a summary of your TRF contributions.

- at the bottom of this report click on the tab labeled ""Transaction details"

This will give the full details of all your contributions to TRF with the dates and amounts provided.

The **Recognition Amount** includes donor dollars (one dollar equals one point) contributed to TRF (Share Fund aka Paul Harris, Polio Plus, or specified restricted funds) plus any bonus points offered by a club or district to promote giving. When the total Recognition Amount reaches 1,000, a Paul Harris award is earned. Each additional 1,000 points earns an additional Paul Harris award in the form of a new pin, e.g., Paul Harris Fellow to Paul Harris +1, etc.

The **Foundation Points Available for Transfer** represent only true dollars given to TRF. One dollar donated equals one point. No bonus points are included in this total. As the name implies, these Points are Available for Transfer to another person, a Rotarian or non-Rotarian. When the Points Available for Transfer reach 1,000 points, the Rotarian has sufficient points to honor someone with a Paul Harris Fellow award. When the donor does honor someone with a Paul Harris award, 1,000 points are subtracted from the donor's Points Available for Transfer total. The donor's Recognition Amount is unchanged.
